

Gift Aid Declaration



South Solihull u3a is registered with the UK Inland Revenue as a Charity. This enables us to claim back the Income Tax associated with individual annual subscriptions made with a Gift Aid declaration. If you pay Income Tax we invite you to complete the attached declaration and return it with your annual subscription.

Please note:

1. You must pay an amount of Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax at least equal to the tax the charity claims on your donation in the tax year.
2. You can cancel this declaration at any time by notifying the Treasurer of South Solihull u3a.
3. If, in the future, your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and Capital Gains equal to the tax that the charity reclaims, you can cancel your declaration.
4. If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief ask the Treasurer, or ask your tax office for leaflet IR65.
5. Please notify the membership secretary if you change your name or address.
